

Dec 2010 – Elimpus visit China

Earlier this month Elimpus visited China to carry out preliminary market research and conduct demonstrations of technology using PDtect®4 Surveyor equipment. During the visit Elimpus attended several presentations and technical meetings with potential distributors as well as representatives of State Grid in Shanghai, Wuhan and Yichang (3 Gorges Dam).
